Traffic Matters

The District Attorney's office will continue to work with defense attorneys to resolve as many traffic tickets as possible during this time. Citizens cited for traffic offenses should check <http://onlineservices.nccourts.gov/> to see if their citation is eligible to be handled without appearing in court.

Pending **New Hanover County** traffic court dates that cannot be resolved online or by a defense attorney will be automatically rescheduled to the following dates:

March 20, 2020 to May 15, 2020

March 27, 2020 to May 22, 2020

April 3, 2020 to May 29, 2020

April 17, 2020 to June 5, 2020

Pending **Pender County** traffic court dates will also be automatically rescheduled to a future date; citizens will receive a printed notice from the Clerk's Office.

Driving School

New Hanover and Pender County defendants who are eligible for CFCC's Defensive Driving School should register online at <https://cfcc.edu/defensive-driving/>. Students will have 14 days to complete the required class online, after which they can pay any court fees online.
